#### TREES FOR SURVIVAL

The Trees for Survival kaupapa provides an opportunity for our tamariki to make a practical difference out in our community, as well as learning about conservation, revegetation, wetland restoration and protecting stream quality.

Potting our native seedlings up for the 2024 year is a two stage process. Initially we have to fill 900-1000 bags with compost and allow these to settle. Step two... we then VERY carefully transplant 900-1000 native seedlings from plugs into these bags. From here we nurture them in our growing units until August / September next year when we will plant them out in the community. We have recently acquired a rain monitoring system which enables us to ensure we are conserving water but also giving our seedlings what they need to grow. Thank you Mark and Kathryn for making this happen and your continued support to make this an enjoyable experience for our students.




